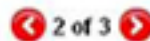
HE'S mad fer . . . marital bliss, eh?

LIAM GALLAGHER VOWS TO 'LIVE FOREVER' WITH NICOLE

The honeymoon's already over for newlyweds Liam Gallagher and Nicole Appleton. The pair, who tied the knot on Valentine's Day, shared a lingering kiss on the steps of their north London home as the Oasis frontman prepared to fly back to LA to complete the band's seventh album. As they said their goodbyes, their six-year-old son Gene – dressed in Ugg boots like Mum – seemed more interested in playing on his scooter.

The pair tied the knot in a low-key ceremony at the Old Marylebone Town Hall – where Liam wed first wife Patsy Kensit in 1997. Watching them

exchange vows were Nicole's sister and former All Saints bandmate Natalie, who attended with her husband Liam Howlett, and Liam's son Lennon from his marriage to Patsy. Following the civil ceremony, the couple hosted a small soiree at the Landmark Hotel.

A friend said of the low-key ceremony: "They felt they were married anyway. He has worn a ring on his wedding finger for years to show his commitment. But he decided it was the right time."

And the celebrations look set to continue for Liam: Oasis has just secured first and second places in a new chart of the best British albums.
